The end result of many disease processes, ranging from diabetic neuropathy to nerve damage after back surgery, is pain. In some cases, this pain can be severe to the point that it interferes with all aspects of daily life. The medical profession has made the understanding and treatment of pain a priority over the past decade.

One of the tools available for the treatment of severe pain is electrical stimulation, which is used as a way to obscure pain perception in the nervous system by providing a more pleasant sensation in its place. It works for the same reason we rub our knee after knocking into the coffee table; it simply feels better when you rub it.

The medical profession has made the understanding and treatment of pain a priority over the past decade

Scientists and physicians have recorded the benefits of mild electrical stimulation in the relief of pain for millennia. As early as 15 A.D., Scribonius ordered torpedo fish treatment for pain in general after feeling the benefits for his own gout. Fast forward to the late 1960s when neurosurgeons at Case Western Reserve University implanted electrical leads along the covering of the spinal cord to provide pain relief in a terminal cancer patient.

The technology for spinal stimulation for pain has been available since 1968 and its utility, effectiveness, safety, and cost efficiency has been improved on greatly since that time. Currently, over fifteen thousand spinal stimulators are implanted each year for the treatment of severe pain. Often patients suffer without knowing that they could be a candidate for trial spinal stimulation.

In general, stimulation works

best for nerve related pain in the arms or legs rather than mechanical/ arthritic pain of the back or neck. An evaluation by a board certified pain specialist is required to determine if you are a candidate to try the device at home. After a brief office procedure to insert the trial lead, patients return to their daily routine controlling the device through an external battery operated power source about the size of an iPod.

Patients use the device for several days and can determine for themselves how beneficial (or not) spinal stimulation is for their pain syndrome. For many patients, spinal stimulation turns out to be a very significant tool in their management of chronic nerve pain, allowing them to more easily meet the needs of daily living.

We have come a long way from the time of using torpedo fish, but the principle is still the same; mild medical grade electrical stimulation of a damaged nerve can indeed ease the perception of pain.

Back and neck pain can be treated.

Back and neck pain are among the most common reasons for doctor visits, and are major causes of disability, lost work days, and high healthcare costs. Back or neck pain is a symptom, not a disease. That means the pain is likely being caused by something that can often be relieved when treated by the board certified physicians at The Spine Care Center.

Genicular Ablation For Knee Pain

Genicular ablation is an innovative option for treating knee pain without surgery. Usually it is preceded by a diagnostic block with local anesthetic agent. If adequate pain relief is confirmed, patients may proceed for radiofrequency ablation (RFA) or neurotomy.

The Genicular RFA procedure is performed with specialized RF needles which will be placed on the target, the genicular nerve branches of the knee. After confirming the placement of needles with fluoroscopic guidance, RFA will be performed where the tips of the needles will be heated to 80°C (176°F) for 90 seconds. This will disrupt the nerves which transmit pain from the joint. This procedure is performed under mild sedation with local anesthesia.

The pain relief from this procedure may last anywhere from 6-12 months.

Risks and Side Effects

There are few risks associated with genicular RFA, but they tend to be rare. The potential risks include, immediate or delayed allergic reaction to anesthetics/contrast, infection, bleeding, temporary increase in pain and transient facial flushing.

Eye allergies, called allergic conjunctivitis, are a common condition that occurs when the eyes react to something that irritates them (called an allergen). The eyes produce a substance called histamine to fight off the allergen. As a result, the eyelids and conjunctiva - the thin, filmy membrane that covers the inside of your eyelids and the white part of your eye (sclera) - become red, swollen and itchy, with tearing and burning. Unlike bacterial or viral conjunctivitis, allergic conjunctivitis is not spread from person to person.



The most common eye allergy symptoms include:

- Red, swollen or itchy eyes
- Burning or tearing of the eyes
- · Sensitivity to light

People who suffer from eye allergies usually (though not always) have nasal allergies as well, with an itchy, stuffy nose and sneezing. It is usually a temporary (acute) condition associated with seasonal allergies. However, in other cases, eve allergies can develop from exposure to other environmental triggers, such as pet dander, dust, smoke, perfumes, or even foods. If the exposure is ongoing, the allergies can be more severe, with significant burning and itching and even sensitivity to light.

Many eye allergies are caused by the body's response to allergens in the air - both indoors and out - such as dust, pet dander, mold, or smoke. Some of the most common airborne allergens include pollen from grass, trees and ragweed, contributing to seasonal allergies.

Some people can inherit eye allergies from their parents. You're more likely to have allergies if both of your parents have them than if only one does.

To provide proper treatment, your ophthalmologist will check to see whether your symptoms are related to an eye infection or allergic conjunctivitis. He or she can usually diagnose allergic conjunctivitis easily by examining your eyes and discussing your medical history - including your history and your family's history of allergies.

The key to treating eye allergies is to avoid or limit contact with the substance causing the problem. But you have to know what to avoid. If necessary, an allergist can perform a skin or blood test to help identify the specific allergen(s). Those most common are:

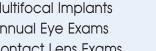

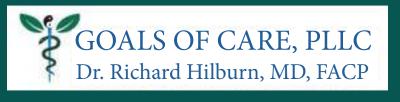

Holistic practice encourages regular exercise, proper nutrition, spiritual wellness, healthy intimacy, effective sleep, risk avoidance and minimizing environmental hazards. For example, we know that ginger and curcumin help support some immune functions and Tai Chi reduces geriatric falls, improves mood and promotes overall well-being. However these kinds of things aren't sufficient for taking care of someone with Parkinson's disease, diabetic vascular disease or malignancy. We know that transcendental meditation is very effective for anxiety, depression and disorganized sleep, but it's not sufficient for treating obstructive sleep apnea.

A holistic approach helps discover those lifestyle factors that are contributing to suboptimal health, leaving patients vulnerable to disease and debility that they might be able to prevent or at least modulate. When the holistic agenda is well-addressed, traditional western medicine works much better and patients' quality of life is optimized.

Dental Implants FAOs

You can't grow new teeth, but dental implants offer the next best thing if you've lost a tooth. A dental implant looks like a tiny screw and replaces the roots of a tooth. During a minor surgical procedure, your dentist creates a small opening in your jawbone and places the implant inside. Over the course of several months, the implant fuses to the bone, providing a secure foundation for the crown that will be placed on top of it. In some cases, you may receive a temporary crown the same day you receive your implant.

Replace Multiple Teeth - When you have more than one tooth missing, implants provide an ideal replacement mechanism. You don't even need one implant for every missing tooth. Instead, implant teeth can act as supports for fixed bridgework. For example, if you are missing three teeth in a row, we can place two implants, one on either side of the gap, and a crown in between that has no implant underneath. That way, you won't need to use any of your remaining natural teeth as bridge supports, which could weaken them and make them more susceptible to decay.

Replace All Teeth Permanently - Implants can support an entire arch of upper or lower replacement teeth that are fixed into the mouth and are never removed. Sometimes the new teeth can be supported by as few as four implants. It's comparable to the

Dental Care For Mature Citizens

If you're a baby boomer, born between 1946 and 1964, there are so many reasons to focus on and improve your oral health. Periodontal (gum) disease risks rise with age and can lead to a host of physical problems. Higher Risk Of Periodontal Disease

There, they release enzymes that can destroy nerve cells, leading to memory loss and Alzheimer's.

The relationship between dementia and gum disease goes the other way, too: People with memory loss may neglect their oral health and a mild problem may turn into something much more severe.

Protecting Oral Health As You Age

Research is underway to develop a drug that can block bad bacterial enzymes and slow the progression of dementia. Until then, it is imperative to take extra care of your teeth and gums as you age.

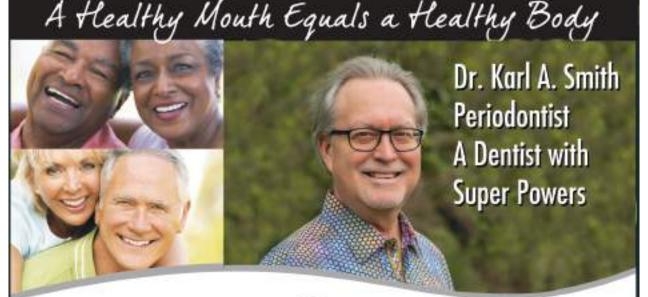

Sleep-Mouth Issues and Your Baby

Did You Know That **Breastfeeding Affects How** Well Your Child's Face and Jaws Grow, and Sets Them Up For **Good Sleep?**

You waited nine months for the arrival of your precious baby. But what happens if you find out you are experiencing excruciating pain during breastfeeding? After all, this powerful instinct is meant to help create the bond between mother and child. Mothers in this situation either power through, supplement with bottle feeding, or they give up altogether, only to suffer from mom guilt.

Many babies have restrictions that make it difficult, sometimes impossible, to breastfeed. Typically, these situations involve anatomic, functional, and sometimes neurological issues with the baby.

When babies are not able to easily breastfeed, this impacts the growth of their face and jaws. The tongue acts as a natural pump while breastfeeding and drives the development of the face, jaws, and airway. When tongue function is compromised, breastfeeding, breathing, sleep, and the growth of the face and jaws are adversely affected.

We are born as obligate nose breathers, which means that nature intended that our tongues lay on the roof of our mouth and that we breathe exclusively through our nose. Open mouth posture and subsequent mouth breathing, noisy breathing, snoring, frequent nose congestion, teeth grinding, allergies and sometimes asthma-like symptoms can occur in the absence of good nasal breathing and often lead to breathing-related sleep disorders.

As the baby grows, non-restorative sleep generally shows as restlessness, lack of focus, attention issues,

anxiety, sensory issues, and other behavioral issues seen in many toddlers and young children. Often many of these children are misdiagnosed as having ADHD.

Other symptoms include:

- · Development of a narrow or long face
- Gummy smile
- Crooked teeth and misaligned jaws
- · Difficult toothbrushing and gagging

- · Sleeping with head and neck hyperextended or with "butt" in the air
- Picky eating
- Bedwetting beyond potty-training
- Sleepwalking

If you notice any of these problems with your child, ask your pediatrician for a referral to a specialist or dental professional who is familiar and educated on the connection of sleepmouth issues to overall health.

Study Of Potential Alzheimer's Treatment

Alzheimer's disease starts with mild memory loss. What if there was a pill to prevent the disease from getting worse?

Studies of an investigational drug are underway to see if it may be effective in slowing the progression of Al-

zheimer's disease in people who carry two copies of a certain gene (APOE/4) that increases the risk of developing it and other dementias.

While one in four people carries one copy of the gene, only 2 to 3% of the population carries two, and hence are at greatest risk.

Results in a small, ongoing phase II trial of the drug in early Alzheimer's patients with two copies of the gene showed "significant improvement" on memory tests after six months, according to Alzheon, a Massachusetts-based

company developing it and a number of potential drugs for Alzheimer's.

Phase three clinical trials of the drug, named ALZ-801, are getting underway. These constitute the final step before the FDA reviews the drug for possible approval. The company's nationwide study is called ApolloE4.

Volunteers Being Sought

In our area, people can participate in the study via Re:Cognition Health - a clinic in Fairfax, Virginia.

Anyone age 50-80 with a diagnosis of mild cognitive impairment (memory loss) is eligible to volunteer. Free genetic testing and testing for Alzheimer's will be done, and participants will be reimbursed for their time.

Participating is also an opportunity to help future Alzheimer's patients, pointed out Monica Bland, operations manager at Re:Cognition Health. "They would be contributing to science and helping people in the future," Bland said.

The 18-month, randomized, doubleblind study requires nine inperson visits to Re:Cognition Health. Participants will also undergo three MRIs or CT scans (their choice).

Half of participants will receive the study drug, and the other half will receive a placebo. Each will take one pill in the morning and one in the evening.

The drug has already been proven safe in phase 1 trials. It has been well tolerated in studies so far when taken twice a day with food. Alzheon is hopeful the treatment will eventually save millions from suffering from Alzheimer's disease.

Currently there are no approved drugs that stop or prevent the clinical decline typical of Alzheimer's disease.

"Our end goal is to help patients [by providing] other options for Alzheimer's disease medications, because there is not much out there," Bland said. "The FDA-approved drugs aren't doing much." For more information or to volunteer to participate in the ApolloE4 study, call 571-418-0142.

Staying well hydrated is one of the best things you can do for your oral and overall health.

Although bottled water is commonly perceived as being the "cleaner" alternative to tap water, it is missing one vital component – fluoride. Many experts attribute the recent rise in cavities to be linked to the surge of bottle water consumption.

What Are the Benefits Of Tap Water?

Fluoride can slow the rate at which tooth enamel demineralizes and also encourage remineralization of an area that has the early stages (white spots) of a cavity. According to the American Dental Association, "studies prove water fluoridation continues to be effective in reducing tooth decay by 20-40%, even in an era with widespread availability of fluoride from other sources, such as fluoride toothpaste.

Fluoridation is one public health program that actually saves money. An individual can have a lifetime of fluoridated water for less than the cost of one dental filling."

Tap water also contains calcium and magnesium. There have been studies that show that communities that have tap water containing higher levels of calcium and magnesium have lower death rates since they can help protect against heart disturbances.

Is Tap Water Safe?

Although water fluoridation is safe and beneficial for our oral health, over exposure to fluoride can cause dental

fluorosis. Fluorosis in most cases is generally mild, but may cause some whitish spots on the permanent teeth.

For infants who are on formula that already contains fluoride, parents should take caution when reconstituting with fluorinated water. Talk to your pediatrician before altering the diet for your infant. Fluoride toothpaste and rinses should also not be consumed, since it contains a dangerous level of fluoride if ingested in large amounts.

If you are on well water or are unsure of the fluoride levels in your community you may consider getting your water tested. If you have concerns about water quality, contact the Service Authority of your county. Chlorine is a product that is added to water during the filtration process that helps get rid of bacteria. Refrigerating your tap water overnight and using a water filtration system, can help remove impurities and give your tap water a crisp clean taste.

If there is no fluoride in your community water please ask your dentist to determine if your child may be in need of a fluoride supplement.

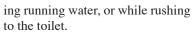

• **Pediatric Incontinence:** Most children are potty trained by age 4. However, some children develop persistent problems that may include bedwetting, daytime incontinence, urinary frequency, pelvic pain, and constipation.

Pelvic Pain

Pelvic pain can present itself as vaginal, rectal, or perineal pain during sitting, sexual intercourse, urination, and more. This pain may be from various sources such as lower back dysfunction, pubic symphysis separation, adhered scars, visceral restriction, vaginal tears, hormonal imbalance, abuse, or prolonged pelvic muscle spasms such as in levator ani syndrome.

Pelvic Prolapse

When the muscles and ligaments of the pelvis get weakened and stretched from pregnancy, constipation, and other conditions, the pelvic organs (bladder, uterus or rectum) drop from the lower abdomen into the walls of the vagina. Patients with prolapse complain of a bulge or heaviness in their vagina.

Pregnancy and Postpartum Conditions

During and after pregnancy, it is common for women to experience back, coccyx, or pelvic pain, to leak urine, or to have separation of the abdominal wall known as diastasis recti. These conditions should be treated, as they respond well to therapy and often do not correct themselves. In fact, 76.4% of women with incontinence at 3-months postpartum report persistent incontinence 12 years later. For those who ignore the pelvic pain associated with pregnancy, 30% become chronic pelvic pain sufferers later in life.

What To Expect During Therapy

A women's health physical therapist will provide a thorough evaluation and develop an individualized treatment program specific to your problems and functional goals. Treatments will include a combination of hands-on manual therapy, functional activity, bladder and bowel training, posture correction, and muscle strength and coordination training. Look for a therapist who listens to you, understands your goals, and creates an individualized plan to meet your specific needs.

TMJ and Vision Disorders Is There a Connection?

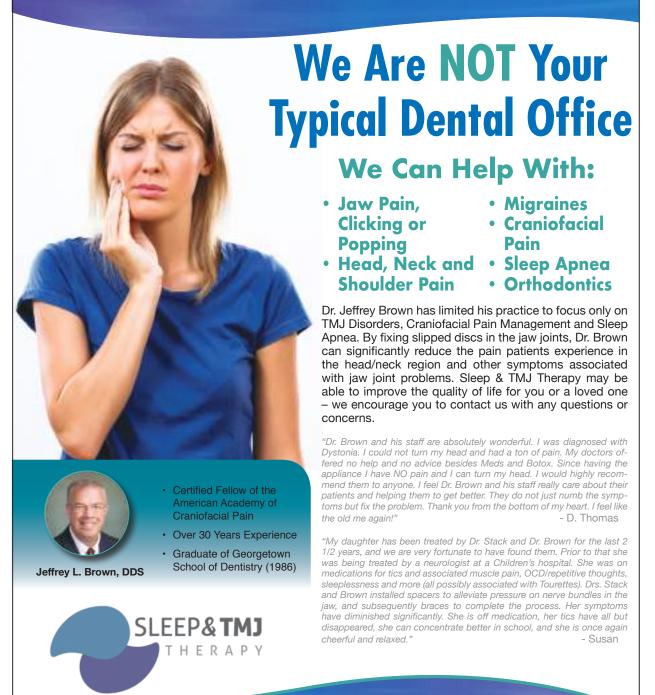
If you ask most doctors if there is a connection between TMD (Temporomandibular Disorder) and vision. they will say there is not. However, if you really think about it, there can most certainly be a connection. The reason is the articular discs (jaw joint discs) are out of place, and inflammatory reaction sets into the body causing problems. This inflammation can work its way throughout the entire body and will have a negative effect on many systems. Did you know that TMJ disorder correlates with many disease states and even to cancer? One of the overlapping symptoms of oral cancer is jaw pain. Going further, if you have slipped discs in the jaw joints, this might affect the eyes and your vision can be compromised with blurry vision.

Another poorly understood aspect of vision disorder can also correlate to distortion of the cranial bones. Research indicates that around 95% of us have bones in the skull that are not in alignment - i.e. they are distorted to some extent. Oftentimes, it is the sphenoid bone that goes right behind the eyes that is not level. When the sphenoid is not level as it should be, this will have the effect of making the eyes uneven which could cause distortion to your vision. If you ever notice that the frames of your glasses - the arm of the eyeglasses for example - are not level when you take your glasses off, it could be due to an uneven sphenoid bone. So now imagine you are walking down the street and your head is tilted to one side. This makes the eyes tilt as well and you can feel dizzy from this experience. Another observation might be that one eye is forward relative to the other due to a different kind of cranial distortion. This means one eye is ahead of the other. This will also cause potential eye problems due to the imbalances.

What does a person do about these issues? Well, maybe it's a simple matter of vision correction: glasses, contacts, Lasik, etc. But what about a way to correct these imbalances? This is where the ALF wire steps in. This little wire is so gentle and ever so lightly levels the bones of the cranium while opening up a bit of the 'tight' areas in the skull. The leveling effect will help the bones become even and the eyes respond accordingly. The effect of opening takes pressure off the skull and even the eyes. This might help with vision distortions from the imbalances.

What does all this mean? It is often not as simple as seeing the op-

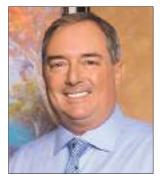
tometrist and getting vision correction. It might also be logical to discuss with an ALF dentist if the cranial bones have some degree of distortion and if this can be corrected as well! This may not seem to be in the normal realm of what we normally would consider, but when you think about it, it really makes sense!

Dry Eye Relief Is In Your Teeth, Improve Sight With Optilight

Dry eye is a common condition that occurs when your tears aren't providing enough lubrication for your eyes. Tears can be inadequate for many reasons, including not making enough tears or producing poor-quality tears.

Dry eyes feel uncomfortable and may sting or burn. Other symptoms may include redness, light sensitivity, irritation, difficulty wearing contact lenses, blurred vision, or eye fatigue. Some people experience watery eyes,

which is the body's response to the irritation. You may experience dry eyes in certain situations, such as on an airplane, in an air-conditioned room, or after looking at a computer screen for a few hours.

What's in a tear? They're a complex combination of water, for moisture; oils, for lubrication; mucus, for even spreading; and antibodies and special proteins that prevent infection. For some people, the cause of dry eyes is decreased tear production. For others it's increased tear evaporation and an imbalance in the tear chemistry.

The tear film has three basic layers: oil, water and mucus. Problems with any of these layers can cause dry eyes. Common causes of decreased tear production include aging, certain medical conditions, including diabetes, rheumatoid arthritis, lupus, thyroid disorders, vitamin A deficiency and certain medications. Laser eye surgery can also cause this type of dry eye, although it is usually temporary.

Increased tear evaporation can be

Weight Loss With Ozempic

Ozempic (which contains the active peptide semaglutide) is a medication used to treat overweight, obesity and type 2 diabetes. It works by mimicking the effects of a hormone called glucagon-like peptide-1 (GLP-1) in the body. GLP-1 is a hormone that is released in response to eating, and it helps to regulate blood sugar levels and reduce appetite.

Ozempic is not for everyone. Pregnant women, those who have experienced pancreatitis or gallstones, or those who have a family history of thyroid cancer, may not be candidates for this medication.

As with any medication, it is important to follow the instructions for use and work with your healthcare provider to develop a plan that is most appropriate for you. Overall, Ozempic shows promising results in the field of weight management. However, a comprehensive approach to health, including diet and exercise, is vital to successful weight loss and maintenance. The potential benefits of Ozempic are encouraging. 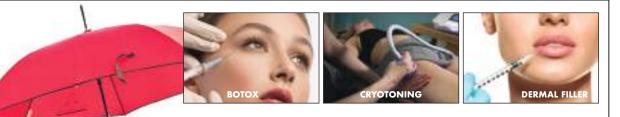

Advantages Of Dental Implants Over Dentures and Partials

During this age of the internet, space travel, medical miracles, GPS, and yes, smart phones, people still suffer with dentures and partial dentures. Other than the materials, the methods to make dentures have not changed since Wellington defeated Napoleon at Waterloo. Complete dentures are not your teeth.

During this age of the internet, space travel, medical miracles, GPS, and yes, smart phones, people still suffer with dentures and partial dentures.

They are a prosthesis made for appearance and very limited function. Complete dentures, at best, have no less than 30% mobility for the upper and the lower is worse and lifts up from the lower jaw by as much as 10 millimeters during eating. Partial dentures function a bit better, but they too move.

This movement acts to abrade teeth, slowly extract teeth and cause an increased rate of dental decay, due to the clasps acting as plaque traps. Both complete dentures and partial dentures destroy supporting bone. As for function, they are like wearing a pair of flip-flops in a foot race. They are basically for show and not for go.

Dental implants offer a superior solution to the above mentioned problems. The following will compare dental implants to dentures and partial dentures.

Dentures require a training period, implants do not. During the implant insertion appointment, you may receive a temporary bridge that will not come loose. When you get your permanent bridge, you will be able to eat, laugh, and talk just like normal.

Implants will not make your face look sunken in or change the shape of your face. In other words, you will not have the denture look. There is no such thing as an implant look. Many times, implants can improve the appearance over one's own natural teeth. They can improve the shape, color, gaps and crookedness often looking much better than ever. Denture wearers and those with partially missing teeth usually have an improvement of their

facial appearance, much better than any plastic surgery.

Dental implants usually improve ones speech, because you do not have the movement or slippage that you get with dentures. So you don't get the lisping, clicking or sucking sounds that you have with dentures.

Children often have iPads and TVs at each dental chair, and there is a toy car in the dental cleaning bay which serves as a lowthreat way to start the appointment.

The staff interaction and feel is different

In a general dentist's office, the staff interaction is professional and terminology is straightforward, while in a pediatric office, the staff interacts with young patients in a playful manner, and use language to help relax children.

Instead of the term "suction tube," we use "Mr. Thirsty," the water laser is called the "rain brush," and the handpiece drill is referred to as "Mr. Bumpy." The "x-ray unit" is a "camera" and the "lead apron" is a "blanket." Conversation is focused on Disney and tween movie characters, or school sports and afterschool activities, rather than world news. Counting and nursery songs help the exam go by quickly and pleasantly.

Training and expertise are different

A general dentist's skill and expertise is focused on management of permanent teeth anatomy and treatment. The pediatric dentist has 2-3 years of additional specialized training when it comes to management of pediatric (primary) teeth, proper sequence of teething, child psychology and cooperation techniques, as well as caring for patients with medical and/or behavioral special needs.

The technology is different

Besides the ever-popular electronic devices children use, equipment used for dental appointments differs in a pediatric dental practice. It includes digital x-ray imaging (reduces the radiation up to 90%), specially-sized equipment such as the pediatric-sized x-ray sensors and small brush head-sized intra-oral camera. These allow us to educate parents and monitor cavity-susceptible areas more comfortably on a computer screen rather than inside little mouths.

Topical gel and laser technology reduces or eliminates the need for a local anesthetic shot, so children can avoid the discomfort of numb lips, cheeks and tongues. They can return to normal activity – play or school – immediately after cavity fillings.

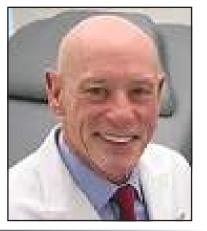

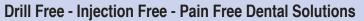

How Orthodontic Treatment Benefits Adult Patients

Many people seek orthodontic treatment for an attractive smile. However, the benefits of orthodontic treatment go beyond the obvious physical changes of straight teeth.

Malocclusion is the technical term used by orthodontists for crooked, crowded and protruded teeth. Literally the word means "bad bite." Untreated malocclusions or bad bites can lead to speech problems, uneven tooth wear, chewing and periodontal problems.

A bad bite often distributes pressure unevenly across the mouth and puts unhealthy forces on the bones that support the teeth and chewing muscles. If left untreated, years of uneven chewing and grinding in this pattern can lead to problems, such as headaches, TMJ syndrome, and face and neck pain.

Crowded teeth are often difficult to brush and floss, while spacing between teeth leads to food impaction. Both conditions make it harder to keep the teeth clean. Over a period of time these problems can lead to tooth decay, gum diseases, bone loss and possible loss of teeth.

Neuromas Cause Pain and Swelling

A neuroma is a pinched nerve between the metatarsal bones in the ball of the foot causing swelling, pain, inflammation and sometimes numbness. A neuroma most often occurs at the base of the third and fourth toes and occasionally between the second and third toes.

What causes a neuroma? Neuromas can be caused by wearing high heeled or tight shoes. Shoes that are too narrow or pointed squeeze the bones at the ball of the foot. High heeled shoes put additional pressure on the ends of the bones. When the bones are squeezed together they pinch the nerve that runs between them.

The most common symptom of a neuroma is pain in the ball of the foot between the toes. There may be occasional shooting pains through the forefoot or numbness of the toes. The symptoms typically occur after walking or standing for an extended period of time.

Treatment is aimed at decompressing the pinched nerve, reducing inflammation and relieving the pain. Treatment may include wearing wider shoes, using special pads in the shoes and medication. Removing your shoes and rubbing the balls of your feet may temporarily relieve the pain.

If these steps do not relieve the pain a podiatrist may prescribe a regimen of physical therapy ultra-sound, hydro-therapy and/or injections of cortisone with an anesthetic into the interspaces. Custom-made orthotic devices are usually prescribed to control pronation and take pressure off of the nerve.

If these conservative steps fail to relieve pain, surgical intervention may be required. The surgery is an

Cesarean Section Defects and Subsequent Fertility

Cesarean sections are usually done in over 20% of deliveries globally. In the US, nearly a third of deliveries are by cesarean (31.9% in 2018), with rates above 36.0% in several states.

In the three years following first

childbirth, women who delivered their first child by cesarean had lower rates of conception after unprotected intercourse, and fewer of these women had a second child than those who delivered vaginally.

There can be sequelae from cesarean delivery on subsequent ability to conceive. These sequelae are magnified in the presence of a cesarean section scar also called a niche or a cesarean-induced isthmocele.

A niche as defined by their European niche task force as an indentation of the uterine myometrium of at least 2 mm at the site of the cesarean scar assessed by transvaginal ultrasound. The diagnostic criterion of the niche includes a hypoechoic space failed with postmenstrual blood most typically in a triangular shape reflecting

a discontinuation of the myometrium at the site of the previous cesarean section. A large niche is defined as an incision of a depth of at least 50-80% of the anterior myometrium, or the remaining myometrial thickness less than 2.2 mm when evaluated by transvaginal ultrasound or less than 2.5 mm when evaluated by sonohysterography.

Niches are observed in 50-60% of women following a cesarean section. Several factors have been shown to be associated with the development of a cesarean section niche. There are some maternal factors that can contribute to poor healing of tissue such as diabetes and smoking. A study by Hayakawa et al., demonstrated that double-layer interrupted sutures reduced the prevalence of a cesarean section myometrial defect after at 30–38 days after surgery.

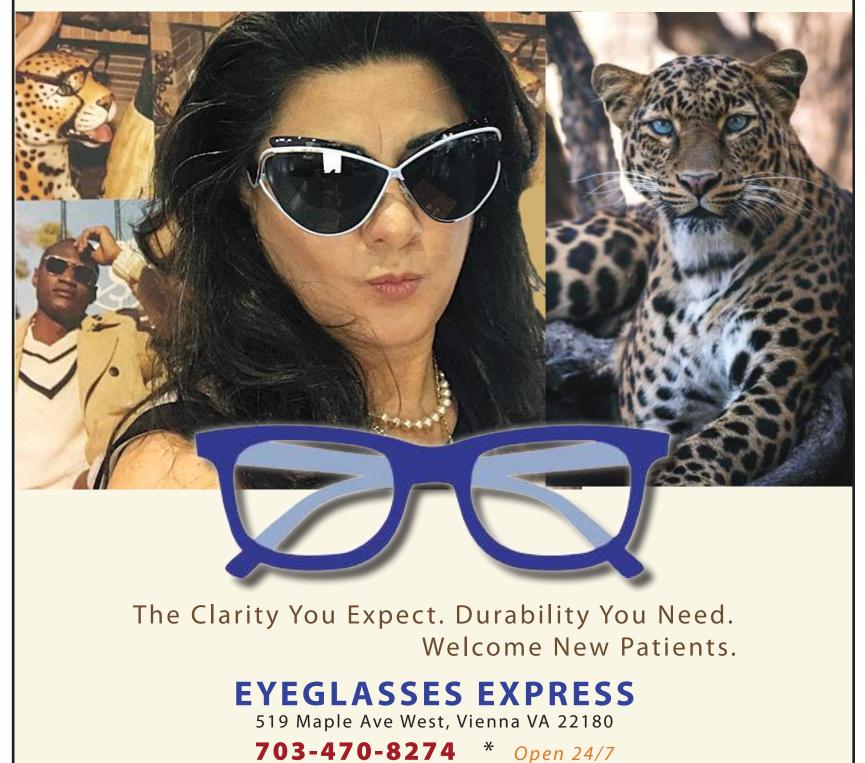
Cesarean section niches can result in a spectrum of disorders starting with cesarean scar ectopic pregnancy, to increased incidence of placenta previa and uterine rupture associated with major maternal morbidity, and even mortality. Cesarean section niches collect menstrual blood, resulting in abnormal peri-menstrual bleeding or spotting. They also cause pelvic pain, painful menstruation, and dyspareunia. The accumulation of blood in this area may also negatively affect the quality of cervical mucus and semen, as well as interfere with semen transport

Another serious sequela may be the implantation of an embryo within the niche resulting in the development of a cesarean scar ectopic pregnancy. This can be a life-threatening complication if not diagnosed on time and adequately treated. The diagnosis of a niche ectopic pregnancy is invariably challenging, as approximately 30% of patients may not present with any symptoms, and in 70% the symptoms mimic early pregnancy. Transvaginal ultrasound is the most accurate differential test, with a sensitivity of 84.6%. Additionally, saline infusion sonohysterography, MR, 3D US and hysteroscopy may also be helpful.

Several studies have reported spotting in up to 30% of women that develop a niche within 6-12 months

areas and in airplanes can be extremely dry. It may be helpful to frequently close your eyes for a few minutes at a time to minimize evaporation of your tears.

compared to 15% of women without a niche. The amount of spotting postmenstrual is correlated to the volume of the niche and inversely correlated to the residual myometrial thickness.

The development of a Cesarean section niche by itself also reduces future fecundity and it is felt that there are three major mechanisms for this to happen. The first is that the defect presents a detrimental environment for sperm penetration and implantation. The niche accumulates intrauterine fluid which has been shown to impair implantation. There is altered immune biology and increased inflammation when the niche is present. The niche itself also distorts the contractility of the uterus.

Several studies have shown that the uterus has a contractile pattern. The fibrosis and interruption of the myometrial layer at the site of the niche can prevent normal contractile patterns. There is accumulation of mucus and blood in the niche which can impair sperm penetration. The second mechanism of decreased fecundity nosis can help the individual reduce their stress levels and improve their sleep quality, which can lead to greater emotional stability and resilience.

not to have surgery for a variety of reasons. If that is the case, a nonsurgical rhinoplasty could help address the patient's concerns. It could be a bump on the nose, an indentation, a scar, an irregularity from a previous nose surgery, or a flattened tip. All these conditions can be improved with a non-surgical rhinoplasty with fillers (injectables).

Lip Fillers

Whatever your lip enhancement desires are, the results can be achieved with a variety of non-surgical and surgical options. For non-surgical lip enhancement, a variety of fillers are available, including Juvederm[®] and Restylane[®].

includes a physical barrier for embryo transfer and implantation. A large niche in combination with a strongly retroflexed uterus impairs accessibility for subsequent embryo transfer in a future IVF cycle. This is due to the distorted anatomy at the niche site. The third mechanism of reduced fecundity could be related to gynecologic symptoms which interfere with sexual intercourse and may interfere with opportunities to conceive.

The treatment for cesarean section niches is usually surgical. Patients whose main symptom includes spotting or bleeding abnormally can be readily treated by hysteroscopy.

Repairing the niche itself by laparoscopy can improve future fertility. A prospective study looked at patients who had niches. Patients with no clinical symptoms had a mean residual myometrial layer on transvaginal ultrasonography of 5.39 ± 3.34 mm, which could be used as a good reference to predict the recovery of patients after repair surgery. Zhou et al.
